

## Walk 2; The Leg Of Mutton



*Route off the public footpaths* - - - - -

This circular walk follows the country lanes around the caravan site. If you want to extend the walk, especially when the pub is open, follow the alternative route in *italics*. Tarmac roads all the way around.

- 1 The walk starts at Laburnum Cottage on Sandy Lane. From the cottage head east towards Withington on the lane. Watch out for motor vehicles and bicycles using the single track roads. The first part of this walk is part of a Shropshire Cycleway route.
- 2 At the first T-junction, turn left and follow the road round past Manor Farm. *Alternatively carry on into the village following the road to the local pub. Retrace the route from the pub to the first junction, Caernarvon Lane, and head north to re-join the route*
- 3 At the next T-junction turn left, heading north. *From the pub just carry straight on.*
- 4 At the next T-junction turn left past Hollowdene Farm and head west towards Upton Magna. The farm will sell free range eggs to passing trade. The road dips into a small valley then gently rises.
- 5 At the next crossroads carry straight on towards Upton Magna. *At this point you can shorten the walk by turning left down the narrow lane and left again at the bottom of the lane.*
- 6 At the T-Junction at the end of the road turn left and head east towards Withington. A signpost on the road points the way. Keep going until you return to Laburnum Cottage.
